



Explore the City itinerary

Explore Portsmouth with a guided walking tour before enjoying a birds-eye view of your route from 100 metres up.

On arrival: A coach drop-off point is available at Portsmouth's Anglican Cathedral, PO1 2HH. Coach parking can then be found at D-Day Car & Coach Park, St. George's Road or Museum Road for the whole day for a £5 rate. Explore our Coach Parking information guide [here](#).

10am – Walking Tour, in partnership with Visit Portsmouth

The 1.5 hour walking tour begins at the historic city's 13th century Royal Garrison Church. Learn about the origins of Portsmouth and the site of the original Norman fishing settlement, see three 15th century fortifications and, bringing it right up to date, the newest building in the harbour – the Ben Ainslie Racing base.



11.30am – Emirates Spinnaker Tower, Gunwharf Quays, Portsmouth. PO1 3TT

Discover details of the Tower's history, construction and key viewpoints on a 30 minute guided tour. Then explore the Tower at your leisure and take in the spectacular 350° panoramic views on offer from the view decks, 100 metres above sea level. The Tower's unique position provides an incredible outlook stretching for up to 23 miles over the historic harbour, the Solent and the Isle of Wight.



1pm – Lunch at Waterfront Café

All group members will be given 15% off vouchers which are valid in the Tower's ground floor Waterfront Café (and the Tower souvenir shop). Choose from a selection of hot and cold meals, light bites and sweet treats to recharge your batteries, whilst taking in the glorious harbour-side views available from the floor-to-ceiling windows.



2pm – Free time in Gunwharf Quays

After lunch, enjoy some free time exploring the 90 designer outlet stores on offer at [Gunwharf Quays](#). With a selection of top brands including Ralph Lauren, Michael Kors and Molton Brown, you won't be short of shops to explore. You may also wish to pre-book a [Harbour Tour](#) which you can pick up from the Gunwharf Quays marina, with a 45 minute overview of Portsmouth Harbour, its fortifications and key landmarks along the coastline.



4pm – Cream Tea in Waterfront Café

Return to Waterfront Café to round off the day with a traditional Cream Tea experience. Indulge in a delicious scone with cream and jam served with your choice of tea or coffee as you sit back, relax and enjoy the views.



5pm – End of day

The coach driver can pick the group up using the Gunwharf Quays coach pick up point.
