



Three Ships and a Sail itinerary

Combine the old and the new with a trip to the city's most iconic modern landmark, shaped as a Spinnaker sail, before exploring a trio of the Royal Navy's most famous warships at [Portsmouth Historic Dockyard](#).

On arrival: Take advantage of our access to a Gunwharf Quays coach parking bay for just £5 (subject to availability; must be pre-booked). Plus, request one of our Coach meet and greets and an Emirates Spinnaker Tower team member will be on hand on arrival to guide your group on the short walk to the Tower entrance, regaling them with a selection of City facts and top tips for getting the most out of your visit along the way.

10am – Emirates Spinnaker Tower, Gunwharf Quays, Portsmouth. PO1 3TT

Recommended visit time: 45 minutes to 1 hour

Start your Portsmouth visit on a high at [Emirates Spinnaker Tower](#). Its unique position provides visitors with incredible views stretching out for up to 23 miles over the historic harbour, the Solent and the Isle of Wight. Appreciate the 1700 years of history encapsulated in the outlook, with highlights including Portsmouth Historic Dockyard and Southsea Castle.

Optional: Back on the ground floor, stop off for a refreshment break in the Tower's [Waterfront Café](#). With panoramic harbour-side views, your group can savour the outlook whilst enjoying our Cake and Hot Drink catering package for just £4 (must be pre-booked).



11.30am – Walk across to Portsmouth Historic Dockyard (5 – 10 minute walk)

Recommended visit time: 4 -5 hours

Portsmouth boasts a wealth of Naval history to explore. Highlights covered by your all-attraction joint ticket include [HMS Warrior 1860](#), Britain's first iron-hulled, armoured battleship; [Mary Rose Museum](#), housing Henry VIII's cherished warship and the only 16th century warship on display in the world; and [HMS Victory](#), Vice Admiral Lord Nelson's flagship during the Battle of Trafalgar.



4.30pm – Harbour Tour

At the end of your Portsmouth Historic Dockyard visit, hop on the [Harbour Tour](#) which will take you back to Gunwharf Quays. During the 45 minute tour, you will see many of the fortifications that were built to protect Portsmouth over the centuries, in particular the Round Tower at the harbour entrance and the Solent forts which formed the centre of a string of fortifications along the coast during the Napoleonic Wars.



5.15pm - End of day

The coach driver can pick the group up using the Gunwharf Quays coach pick up point.
